I have been involved in purebred dogs since the age of 10. I am a second-generation dog person; my parents exhibited Poodles. I assisted by showing the usually untrained Standard Poodle puppies and I participated in Juniors. In my teenage years, I worked after school for Lynn and Dorothy Welsh in a kennel full of Poodles and Rough Collies. In my late teenage years, I went to work as an assistant to Denny Kodner, an all-breed handler, and worked for her for about six years. Mrs. Kodner showed primarily Working and Sporting breeds, including a large number of Best in Show winning German Shepherd Dogs. I then went out on my own as a professional handler. I was a handler for about 25 years, showing a wide range of breeds. I have finished dogs in every Group and have had Best in Show dogs in Sporting, Working, Hound, Terriers, and Non-Sporting breeds.

I began judging about 1996, being approved for 13 breeds, primarily Terriers. I am now approved for all Sporting, Working, Terrier, and Non-Sporting groups, and several Hounds.

I have judged throughout the United States, including five times at Westminster, including the Terrier Group and the Working Group. I also had several assignments at the AKC Royal Canin show. My experience also includes shows in Canada, China, Taiwan, Poland, Finland, Columbia, Venezuela, Hungary, the Czech Republic, Mexico, and Spain.



John started in purebred dogs in 1960 with Pembroke Welsh Corgis, and has bred and owned many breed and group-winning Corgis over the years. He also has bred and owned group winning and placing Scottish Deerhounds, Whippets and Bedlington Terriers. Currently, John and his wife Michelle breed, exhibit and own Borzoi They have bred over 25 champions including breed, group and specialty winners and best in show winners in several countries. In 1970 John worked as an assistant professional handler in the United States. The handler's kennel was also one of the foremost producers of German Shorthair Pointers. He returned to Canada in 1971 where he continued to show dogs. John specialized in showing Working, Herding, Hounds, Terriers and Toys. John is currently licensed by the Canadian Kennel Club to judge All Breeds. He has judged in Canada, the United States, New Zealand, Australia, Taiwan, China and Thailand.



I grew up in a dog show home. My mother, Darlene Ayre, is a 50+ year and life member of the CKC. I have been attending and participating in dog shows my entire life. I started as a junior handler, handling German Shepherd Dogs and Cairn Terriers. I have experience handling a variety of breeds, mostly herding dogs and terriers. I have worked behind-the-scenes and on the front lines of shows, specialties, trials, tests, and sanction matches. My Mom was a show secretary for several clubs and I have fond memories of helping her with entries, schedules, rosettes and prizes. I am currently involved with the Evelyn Kenny Kennel and Obedience Club and have assisted hosting speciality shows; obedience, rally and scent detection trials; and tracking tests for the German Shepherd Dog Club of Canada and the GSD Club of London. I consider myself a life-student of purebred dogs. I am constantly researching, learning about and watching other breeds. My love of learning is serving me well as I work towards my first judging permit, which will be in terriers. I was involved in my mother's breeding program for approximately 10 years, breeding Cairn Terriers under the kennel name of Kinncayre. In addition to conformation, I train and trial in obedience, rally obedience and scent detection.
