IMPORTANT PARTICIPANT INFORMATION

- 1. Indoor benching will not be available. Please be prepared to bench from your vehicle.
- 2. Only one handler and one dog in the building at a time during the test.
- 3. Masks are optional.
- 4. For the Judge's Briefings, all participants are encouraged to follow social distancing protocols.
- 5. Trials will run rain or shine.
- 6. It is the responsibility of the participant to be familiar with the CKC rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing.

IMPORTANT

CKC NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION

The Non-Member Participation fee applies to dogs wholly owned by a resident of Canada who is not a member of the CKC. It is not applicable to CKC members or dogs owned with a CKC member. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. (For a Membership application, please go to www.ckc.ca under CKC Services and Forms On-Line). The Non-Member Participation Fee is paid in the calendar year (January-December) in which the dog achieved its title and/or titles.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on the receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. (See Section 19.7)
- Scent Detection Levels offered Instinct, Novice (Containers, Interior and Exterior) Open (Containers, Interior, Exterior) and Excellent (Containers, Interior, Exterior), Master (Containers, Interior, Exterior). Exhibitors may compete in the same level components with a maximum of two dogs in Novice and Open classes only.
- Mixed and unrecognized breeds will be accepted at this Trial. These dogs must have a CCN (Canine Companion Number) issued by the Canadian Kennel Club in order to participate in this Trial.

- **Bitches in season** bitches are eligible to enter but only one bitch in season/handler/component. Bitches must wear snugly fitting panties and run last in each component. Handler must notify the club prior to trial date for proper scheduling. (See CKC Scent Detection Rule 6.5).
- **Penalties issued by the club** handlers will be charged for any damage done to equipment by dogs (including urinating on items, excessive scratching, or subsequent breaking of any item).
- **Reminder** anyone discussing hides before the end of the trial will be excused and asked to leave as per CKC rules. Please show consideration for other competitors.
