Level One (boxes - one hide. Scents: Birch or Cypress)

Level Two (boxes, containers, objects - 2 hides. Scents: Birch, Cypress and/or Clove Bud)

Level 3 (person, containers, objects - 3 hides. Scents: Birch, Cypress, Clove Bud and/or Lemongrass. Scent may be used more than once)

Level One and Level Two may be entered concurrently Level Three requires a Level One OR Level Two title

Open to all dogs INCLUDING reactive dogs

Special consideration will be held for dogs that need extra space, including no spectators during the runs and entrance to the rings directly from outdoors

Limited Entry

Only 1 dog per handler per round may enter, unless the second dog is FEO.

Entries *may* be accepted day of trial. Move ups are allowed during event.

Judging Assignments & Running Order

* IMPORTANT *

ALL DOGS COMPETING <u>MUST</u> BE REGISTERED WITH C-WAGS TO COMPETE. REGISTRATION MAY BE DONE ON-LINE AT http://www.c-wags.org/.

FACILITIES

This is an indoor facility in Calgary. Limited space for crating indoors is available and there are washrooms and water onsite. Bring your own lunch or take advantage of numerous restaurants/grocery stores within a 10 minute drive.

All dogs must be crated, in an ex-pen, or on leash when not in the ring. Any dog engaging in aggressive behaviour at any time will be required to leave the trial grounds. We ask that all dogs be exercised in the green space to the back of the building.

TRIAL SITE DOES NOT ALLOW THE USE OF CORRECTIVE COLLARS ON-SITE, INCLUDING THE EXERCISE AREA. THIS INCLUDES PRONG, PINCH, CHOKER COLLARS AND E-COLLARS.

ALL CHILDREN MUST BE SUPERVISED BY A PARENT NOT COMPETING IN THE TRIALS.

ANYONE OBSERVED DISCIPLINING THEIR DOG IN A MANNER THAT OFFENDS A JUDGE'S SENSIBILITIES WILL BE EXCUSED AND WILL FORFEIT ENTRY FEES.

Rosettes will be awarded for new titles earned by dog/handler teams.



Volunteer assistance will be required for time keeping, gate stewarding, and setting up of courses. Each time a person volunteers for a role (per round), they will receive a raffle ticket with a chance of winning a prize.

TRIAL SITE LOCATION

The trial will be held at Sit Happens! training facility at #16 2333 18th Ave NE, Calgary, AB



From Deerfoot Trail, take 16th Ave. East. Turn left (north) at the first set of traffic lights, onto 19th St. NE, then turn right (east) at the lights, onto 18th Ave. NE. We are located on the east side of the Furniture Mart, on your right hand side.

NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

- 1. All breeds of dogs and mixed breeds are eligible to compete in C-Wags events.
- 2. Dogs that are physically-challenged are allowed and encouraged to compete, providing they do not show evidence of being in pain or discomfort. The Judge shall excuse any dog that appears to be in pain or discomfort during the competition. A Judge's decision is final.
- 3. Owners who are physically-challenged are allowed and encouraged to compete
- 4. Female dogs in estrus (heat) may not compete. Where a bitch comes into season after the entry of the bitch has been submitted, a Veterinarian's certificate, certifying the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the Trial must reach the Trial Secretary on or before the date of the Trial, whereupon the entry fees will be refunded.
- 5. Dogs exhibiting signs of aggression that threaten the safety of other dogs or humans shall be excused from competition at the discretion of either the Judge or the Trial Chairperson. If the Trial Chairperson believes it is necessary in order to ensure the safety of others, he or she shall request that the dog be removed from the show-grounds or confined in such a manner as to remove the threat to others.
- 6. Dogs must be at least six months of age to compete.
- 7. Dog ID Cards: Dogs may register with C-Wags up to the day of the trial. http://www.c-wags.org/regform.html
- 8. Awards: C-Wags ribbons will be awarded to every dog/handler team who successfully completes an event. C-Wags does not offer placement ribbons. Title ribbons will be available for teams who have successfully completed four runs under 2 judges at the same level. C-Wags allows teams to run level one and level two concurrently. Ribbons will not be awarded to FEO runs.

FEO

Trial hosts may choose to accept entries as FEO at the regular or a reduced entry fee. The scores from this entry are not recorded. The dog may be handled by a non-family member or may be a non-registered team.
