ENTRY INFORMATION

1. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by proper entry fees and forms.
2. Incomplete entries will be returned. Agents and handlers please note that full name and address of owners must be filled in.
3. Telephone and telegraph entries are prohibited under CKC rules.
4. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom entries were made.
5. Changes, cancellations, or substitutions after Closing Date are prohibited.
6. Only dogs eligible for CKC registration may enter this show. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules.
7. A dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements of Championship, in accordance with the provisions of Ch. 20 of these rules, after the closing date and time for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only" providing the request for a transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in writing at least one hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler.
8. All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN). To obtain an ERN number simply do the following. Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership, for example, AKC Registration Certificate with a written request for an ERN number. Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount prescribed payable to the Canadian Kennel Club. Ensure that you provide CKC with your full return address. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicate your Visa / Mastercard number, expiry date, cardholders name and signature.

This ERN must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a C.K.C. event. Dogs may be entered as "listed", however, failure to apply for the ERN number within 30 days of the first event will result in the cancellation of any wins, awards or scores.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Dogs entered in Non-Regular Classes must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, Specials Only, or Exhibition Only.

Stud Dog Class - shall be for Stud Dog and two or more of his Get

Brood Bitch Class - shall be for Brood Bitch and two or more of her progeny

Brace Class - shall be for 2 dogs of the same breed and identical ownership.

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

GUN DOG - shall be for any dog that has earned a title at a WC Test, Hunt Tests or a placement at a Field Trial

FIELD DOG AND FIELD BITCH CLASS - Shall be for a dog of either sex with a CKC/AKC MH, CKC/AKC Licensed Field Trial Placement

Parade of Titleholders - is open to any titleholder of any country.

Parade of Veterans - shall be for all dogs and bitches seven years of age or over

Note: **Parade of Titleholders and Parade of Veterans** - Owners are requested to submit a resume of their dog's accomplishments at the time of entry - limit 100 words.

Note: All Non-Regular Class judging will follow immediately after Best of Breed. Please be sure to mark non-regular classes entered on your regular entry form.

SWEEPSTAKES

Baby Puppy Sweeps shall be for any dog 3 months up to but not including 6 months of age. To enter this class the dog must be entered in the Baby Puppy Class. There will be two classes in all, divided by sex.

Baby Puppy for Golden Retrievers at least 3 months of age up to but not including 6 months. The winners of these classes, Best Baby Puppy Male and Best Baby Puppy Female will compete for Best Baby Puppy in Sweepstakes. A rosette will be awarded to the first, second, third and fourth places in the class and Best Baby Puppy in Sweepstakes.

Puppy Sweeps shall be for any dog 6 months up to but not including 18 months of age. To enter this class the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes or in Specials only. There will be three classes in all, divided by sex.

Junior Class for Golden Retrievers at least 6 months of age up to but not including 9 months.

Senior Class for Golden Retrievers at least 9 months of age up to but not including 12 months.

12-18 Open for Golden Retrievers at least 12 months of age up to but not including 18 months.

The winners of all six classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes. A rosette will be awarded to first, second, third and fourth places in each class as well as to Best in Sweeps and Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps.

VETERANS SWEEPSTAKES

Veterans Sweeps shall be for any dog 7 years of age and up. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes, Specials or Exhibition Only. There will be four classes in all, divided by sex.

7-9 years for Golden Retrievers at least 7 years of age up to but not including 9 years

Over 9 years for Golden Retrievers 9 years of age and older.

For both Puppy and Veterans Sweepstakes the class winners will compete for best in Sweepstakes with the prize money distributed as follows:

50% of the entry fees for each sweeps class will go to the winner of each class;

THE EILEEN BATTLETT "HAT TRICK" AWARD

The Eileen Battley "Hat Trick" Award offers recognition to all Golden Retrievers that successfully participate in a minimum of three events at a Golden Retriever Club of Canada National Specialty. This is not a competition. Each qualifier, who applies for this award, will receive a certificate to honour their achievement. As well, the qualifying dogs will be announced at the following year's Annual General Meeting.

Eligibility

This honour will be awarded to the Golden Retrievers who, during the GRCC National Specialty, receives a placement, pass or qualifying score in three events, one of which must be field:

- Field – WC/I/X pass; Hunt Test pass or Field Trial Placement or CM.
- Conformation – Placement in Regular or Altered classes. Placement in Veterans or Field classes; BOB, BOS, Best Puppy, Judge's Award of Merit.
- Obedience – Qualifying score in a CKC Regular (title eligible) classes only. This includes Veterans jumping at three-quarters of their regular height.
- Agility – Qualifying score in a Regular and Select classes.
- Tracking – Pass – all stakes, including Urban Tracking.
- Rally O – Qualifying score.

The Eileen Battley "Hat Trick" Award application must be received by the Club within 90 days of the final day of all the National Specialty events.

CLASSIFICATIONS

REGULAR CLASSES: The following CKC Regular Classes will be provided for both sexes:

- Baby Puppy** – for dogs at least 3 months and under 6 months of age on the day of the show
Junior Puppy - for dogs at least 6 months and under 9 months of age on the day of the show
Senior Puppy -for dogs at least 9 months and under 12 months of age on the day of the show
12 to 18 Months - for dogs at least 12 months and under 18 months of age on the day of the show
Bred by Exhibitor - for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder
Canadian Bred - for dogs born in Canada, champions of any country excluded
Open - for all dogs
Veterans - for dogs over 7 years of age on the day of the show. Neutered and spayed dogs may be entered in this class.
Specials Only - for dogs which have a recorded CKC registration or Event Registration number and have attained the required points for Championship status. Should a dog which is entered in this class be found either to be not registered or has not completed the requirements for Championship status, all awards earned at the show will be cancelled. Dogs entered in this class will compete for Best of Breed, Best Opposite Sex and Best Puppy if eligible.
Exhibition Only - for dogs 6 months of age who are not in regular class competition.
Sexually altered - for dogs 6 months of age or over which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Brace Class - shall be for two dogs (either sex or mixed) and identical ownership. The class shall be judged after Best of Breed, A brace must be handled by one person on one lead.
Stud Dog Class - shall be for Stud Dog and two or more of his get. Ownership in this class need not be identical. Stud must be entered in a Regular Class or in Exhibition Only. Get must be entered in a Regular class. The stud dog may be spayed/neutered and must be entered in a Regular class or in Exhibition Only. Get must be entered in a Regular class.
Brood Bitch Class - shall be for Brood Bitch and two or more of her progeny . Same rules apply as with the Stud Dog class.

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

Gun Dog Class - shall be for dogs having a Canadian WC, WCI or WCX title, a CKC licensed Field Trial placement in an official class or a title in a CKC licensed Hunt Test. Dogs must be entered in one of the Regular Classes, Specials Only or Exhibition Only. This class will be judged following Regular and Non-Regular class judging.

UNOFFICIAL OBEDIENCE CLASSES

Brace Class - is open to any two dogs of either sex which have attained no less than a CD degree in Canada. It is not necessary that the same person own both dogs. The Brace Class is performed and judged in the same manner as the Novice Class.
Team Class - is open to any four dogs of either sex which have attained no less than a CD degree in Canada. It is not necessary that the same person own both dogs. The Brace Class is performed and judged in the same manner as the Novice Class.
Veterans Class - is open to all dogs seven years of age or older that have an Obedience title. The exercises shall be performed and judged as in the "Novice Class". Dogs entered in the Veterans Class may not be entered in any Regular Class.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The Show/Test/Trial Superintendent will be in full charge of the event which will be governed by CKC rules.
2. Identification cards and judging schedules will be mailed as soon as possible after the Closing Date.
3. The GRCC will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors, or patrons.
4. If because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.
5. Entries will be refunded where Bitches are unable to compete in Obedience due to heats. Veterinary certificate must be provided to the Trial Secretary in order to apply for refund.
6. Judging schedules are broken down and based on 20-25 dogs per hour in conformation, 8 Novice dogs per hour, 7 Open dogs per hour, and 6 Utility dogs per hour. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have the dog at ringside when the dogs class is scheduled for judging. There will be no waiting for dogs.
7. **All dogs must be exercised in the designated exercise areas. Please help us to keep our show areas clean!!**
8. The precincts of the show and trial will extend to the entrances to Exhibition Park.
9. No dogs shall be left in the building overnight.
