All entry fees must be in the hands of our Show Secretary prior to closing date

Personal cheques and money orders for full value only will be accepted, and must be made payable to N.S. German Shepherd Dog Club for all specialties

No post dated cheques accepted. All NSF cheques will be Subject to a charge of \$20.00. N.S.F. cheques are considered non-payment of entry fees and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the show.

Attention USA exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds.

Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par." They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

A copy of the Rules pertaining to Dog Shows & Obedience Trials is available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Each exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the rules of the Canadian Kennel Club regarding their events.

Important Note Regarding Emails & Faxes

It will be the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that any electronic submission, either email, facsimile, or any document transmitted electronically, reaches the proper authority or recipient, within the times and limits as regulated for each document in the CKC Rules & regulations. Sent fax receipts, and/or, copies of sent emails, will not be taken as evidence of receipt by recipients.

A judge officiating at a show shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it is the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that this rule is effectively carried out. (Dog Show Rules, Sec. 4.1.3)

No person may approach a judge, either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Dog Show Rules Sec. 4.1.6)

ATTENTION ALL CANADIANS WHO ARE NOT CKC MEMBERS

Effective January 1, 2011, the CKC has instituted an annual Non-Member Participation Fee for awards and titles for a CANADIAN non-member of the CKC. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by a non-CKC member and are not applicable to CKC members. Non CKC member participants must either purchase a CKC membership or pay the non-member participation fee within 30 days of notification or the CKC will cancel any awards and titles. TROPHY LIST - OBEDIENCE

Suitable prizes will be given for first in each of the official and unofficial classes for both trials.

Suitable prizes will be given for High in Trial.

A Perpetual Trophy is given for the team having the highest combined score for a single class in the two trials.

All perpetual trophies will remain in Nova Scotia. Suitable keepers will be given.

Suitable prizes will be given for the following:

Highest qualifying score in each class
Highest qualifying score by a dog owned by a club member
Highest qualifying score by a dog handled by a handler 16 years of age or under
Highest qualifying score by a dog bred by a club member

TROPHY LIST - RALLY OBEDIENCE

A trophy is presented to club member having the highest combined score in a single class in the two trials – Donated by Cindy MacPherson in memory of Anita McIntyre.

Suitable prizes will be given for Highest qualifying score in each class.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. The Show/Test/Trial Superintendent will be in full charge of the event that will be governed by CKC rules.
- 2. Identification cards and judging schedules will be mailed as soon as possible after the Closing Date.
- 3. The NSGSDC will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors, or patrons.
- 4. If because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.
- 5. Entries will be refunded where Bitches are unable to compete in Obedience due to heats. Veterinary certificate must be provided to the Trial Secretary in order to apply for refund.
- 6. Judging schedules are broken down and based on 20-25 dogs per hour in conformation, 8 Novice dogs per hour, 7 Open dogs per hour, and 5 Utility dogs per hour. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have the dog at ringside when the dog's class is scheduled for judging. There will be no waiting for dogs.
- 7. All exhibitors will be responsible for clean up on the grounds and surrounding areas for their own dogs and/or dogs they are handling.
- 8. The precincts of the show and trial will extend 10' beyond the rings.
- 9. A judge officiating at a show shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it is the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that this rule is effectively carried out. (Dog Show Rules, Sec. 4.1.3)

10. No person may approach a judge, either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Dog Show Rules Sec. 4.1.6)

Champions and championship points - chapter 15

Section 1 - a dog awarded winners at a championship show held under these rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging 0-5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to the dog awarded winners shall be as provided hereunder:
