Section 24-12-3. Non-member participation fee.

### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- Entries must be typewritten or clearly printed, completely filled out and signed. Owners are responsible for errors on entry forms or where hand-writing is not clearly legible. No phone, faxed, telegraphed or late entries will be accepted.
- Section 6.1.10 Bitches in season are not eligible for entry and are not allowed on or near the test grounds.
- Bitches may be subject to vetting.
- Entry and listing fees paid for any dog withdrawn because of estrus, illness or death shall be refunded in full. An appropriate veterinary certificate must be given to the Test Secretary before the start of the test to qualify for a refund. All refunds must be requested in writing. Once the catalogue has been printed, CKC fees, listing fees and/or other applicable fees will be forfeited.
- Working Certificate Test Rules and Regulations Book are available from the Canadian Kennel Club, 200 Ronson Drive, Suite 400, Etobicoke, Ontario, M9W 5Z9
- Additional Premium lists and entry forms are available at www.bcretrievernews.ca
- Males and females will run in the order of the draw or at the discretion of the Marshall.
- Participants shall not wear white or light colored clothing at any time. Handlers may wear a handling jacket for the blinds in the WCX test.
- Section 10.6.3(f) Mechanical bird throwers may be used.
- Ducks will be used in all tests.
- There are no concessions on the test grounds.
- Official CKC Rosettes will be awarded to all qualifying dogs at the end of the test day. NSDTR qualifiers will also be awarded a special memento.
- Section 10.1.6 "No training will be allowed on the test grounds within 24 hours of the start of the test. A bumper thrown by the handler for the purpose of warm-up shall not be considered training."
- If you have any questions or need more information, please contact the test Secretary, do not contact TNT directly.
- Section 14.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the event giving club to see that a judge club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The WC Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
- By attending this test, competitors and spectators acknowledge that the Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retriever Club Of Canada test officials, volunteers and landowners involved **do not accept** liability for any loss, damage or injury incurred by exhibitors, dogs or spectators. Please respect the landowners that have so graciously allowed us on their land by obeying all signage, removing all garbage and debris. Close all gates and park only where advised.

### **DIRECTIONS TO THT KENNELS - WC, WCI, WCX TESTS & VETERANS EVENT SITE**

From Highway #1: Take exit #73 to 264th Street and head South 1 block. Turn left on 52nd Avenue. When you reach 48th Avenue, turn left, and you end up running parallel with Highway #1 where 48th Ave. turns into Watson Road.

From The USA: Aldergrove Border Crossing opens at 8 am. Head North on 13 (264th Street) to 52nd Avenue and turn right. When you reach 48th Avenue, turn left, and you end up running parallel with Highway #1 where 48th Ave. turns into Watson Road.

**From the Pacific Inn and Conference Centre**: Turn right out of parking lot and right on 16<sup>th</sup> Ave. Travel about 24km to Lefeuvre Rd and turn left. Travel about 5.8km and the road will curve left, turning into Watson Rd. TNT is about 100 meters on your left.
