Herding Tested "HT" to be permitted to use the title "Herding Tested" a dog must receive a pass in 2 tests under 2 different judges in a Herding Tested level at approved herding trials. **Herding Started**

"HS" to be permitted to use the title "Herding Started" a dog must receive a qualifying score at 3 trials under a minimum of 2 judges in a Herding Started level at approved herding trials.

Herding Intermediate "HI" to be permitted to use the title "Herding Intermediate" a dog must receive a qualifying score at 3 trials under a minimum of 2 judges in a Herding Intermediate level at approved herding trials.

Herding Advanced "HA" to be permitted to use the title "Herding Advanced" a dog must receive a qualifying score at 3 trials under a minimum of 2 judges in a Herding Advanced level at approved herding trials.

ATTENTION US EXHIBITORS: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian Dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however; they are to be payable in Canadian funds. Please do no mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". NOTE: Effective January 1, 2011 - Non-Member Participation Fee

a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee (\$57.60 + taxes). This is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor who should correspond with the CKC directly.

b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be canceled.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Trial Secretary will be in full charge of the trials that are governed by CKC rules. The Rottweiler Club of Canada will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons. If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refunds of entry will be made.

Dogs need to be ready for judging when called and will be excused when not required for further judging. If a dog is not at the arena after it has been called three times, it will be marked absent. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to have the dog at ringside when the dog is scheduled for judging.

Handlers may not take a training aid of any kind into the arena; either loose or attached to the dog's collar. This includes a whip, PVC pipe, or any other item with the exception of stock stick or shepherd's crook, maximum 1.5 metres (5 ft) in length. It is acceptable for the handler to carry and use a whistle for commanding the dog and to carry the dog's leash. (8.5.1)

Please note: Dogs must be on leash at all times except when working in the ring.

RULES

- 1. The trial precincts include the trial ring and 10 feet surrounding the rings. Only dogs entered in these trials (except stock handling dogs) will be allowed within the precincts of the trial.
- 2. We will use care and diligence for the welfare of all dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume liability in the event of an accident or misfortune, however caused, to dogs, exhibitors or property.
- The CKC shall not be responsible to any member, person, partnership, club or corporation for any loss, damage or injury arising at or by reason of any trial held under CKC rules.
- 4. It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward volunteer or competitor at the Herding Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Herding Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on the receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
- 5. Exhibitors will be responsible for picking up after their dogs.
- 6. This is an outdoor show with limited shelter. Exhibitors should bring their own shade, crates, etc. Event will be held rain or shine dress for weather!
- 7. Exhibitors must sign the waiver form (attached to this Premium List) before competing
- 8. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their dogs while they are on the trial grounds. All dogs must be kept on leash or in crates except when competing.
