NON- MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

Effective January 1, 2012:

- A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC. The fee will be \$59.40 plus applicable taxes.
- The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER

Effective January 1, 1992, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). The ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. An ERN application must be completed and submitted along with a copy of registration documents from a CKC recognized foreign kennel club and the required fee (\$59.40 plus applicable taxes). PERFORMANCE EVENT NUMBER

A Performance Event Number (PEN) allows an unregistrable dog of a CKC breed to participate in competitive events that are appropriate for the breed. To apply for a PEN you must complete a

CKC PEN application and forward it with the appropriate fee to the CKC (\$53.90 plus applicable taxes).

Note: A dog that is eligible for a PEN number may not be entered as a listed dog.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to compete in these trials, a dog must be at least 6 months of age and registered with the CKC, be eligible for registration with the CKC, have an ERN, PEN, or CKC Miscellaneous Certificate. Spayed bitches, debarked dogs, and neutered males are eligible to participate. Bitches when in season are permitted to compete in the trial. They will be run at the end, at the judge's discretion.

ENTRY INFORMATION

No entry will be accepted unless all particulars requested on the Entry Form is completed in full. Handlers or Agents please note that the full name and address of all owners must be filled in. **Incomplete entries will be returned.** No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the entry fees. Telephone & telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.

Confirmation Letters and judging schedules will be sent by email or regular post as soon as possible after the entries close on Wednesday Sept 11, 2019

Tendering of NSF cheques in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment. **Any NSF cheque will be subject to a \$50.00 service charge.**

Courier Entries will be accepted at the Trial Secretary's address. Please sign in the courier's release for "signature not required".

FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark personal cheques "payable in Canadian funds" or "at par". The banks will not clear them. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated.

As of January 2012, all titles will be followed by (s), (d), or (c) signifying the type of stock the title was earned on.

STOCK

Sheep; 3 – 5 sheep each trial.

ALTERNATES LIST

An "alternates" list will be compiled in the order entries are received. Alternates will be allowed to run in the place of absent dogs if the Trial Secretary is notified preceding the trial of the dogs pending absence. Entry fees for an absent dog replaced by an alternate dog shall be refunded. Alternate dogs, which are not able to run, shall have the entry fees refunded.

MOVE UPS

Move up forms will be available at the Trial Secretary's table and must be submitted at least one hour before the next trial,

ROSETTES & RIBBONS

Rosettes will be awarded to High in Trial, for each trial. Rosettes will be awarded to High Qualifying Cardigan Corgi each day. Place ribbons will be awarded to the 1st through 3rd place in each of the following classes: Herding Started, Herding Intermediate, Herding Advanced. Rosettes will be given to all dogs receiving a passing score in Novice Tested and Herding Tested.

PRIZES

Trial #1, #2, #3, #4:

High in Trial each trial

Highest Qualifying Cardigan Corgi each day.

Dogs MUST have qualifying scores to be eligible for prizes. All award donations will be acknowledged in the catalogue. All awards must be claimed at the trials, as none will be mailed.

A complete list of donors to the CCCC will be published in the catalogue.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

No provisions will be made for inclement weather. Please bring your own shade, and water for your dogs.

We ask that you keep the grounds clean. Please pick up after you and your dog at the trial site and at your hotel. Any competitor or spectator not doing so may be asked to leave the premises. Please keep your dogs on leash at all times except when they are working in the trial arena.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Trial Secretary will be in full charge of the trials that are governed by CKC rules. The Canadian Cardigan Corgi Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons. If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refunds of entry will be made.

Dogs need to be ready for judging when called and will be excused when not required for further judging. If a dog is not at the arena after it has been called three times, it will be marked absent. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to have the dog

at ringside when the dog is scheduled for judging. The trial precincts shall consist of all grounds set aside for the use of the CCCC including the area used for parking.

Please note: Dogs must be on leash at all times except when working in the ring.

DISCIPLINE

CHAPTER 15 section 15.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at a Herding Trial held under these regulations is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Herding Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

HERDING TRIAL RULES

The exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Herding Rules and Regulations of the CKC.

GENERAL RULES

1. The Canadian Cardigan Corgi Club will use care and diligence for the welfare of all dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume liability in the event of an accident or misfortune, however caused, to dogs, exhibitors or property.
2. Dogs must be kept under control at all times, and must be kept on leash at all times or crated, except when competing.
3. The CKC shall not be responsible to any member, person, partnership, club or corporation for any loss, damage or injury arising at or by reason of any herding test/trial held under any rules adopted by the CKC.
4. Only dogs entered in these trials (stock dogs excepted) will be allowed within the precincts of the trial.
5. Maximum time allowed for each run will be announced at the handler's meeting. The course design for each class will be posted one hour before the start of the trial.
6. Exhibitors will be responsible for picking up after their dogs.
7. Water will be available for dogs to cool off in. There is limited shade. Exhibitors are advised to bring their own shade, crates, etc.
8. Dogs may be shown on a plain buckle collar or quick release collar.
9. Exhibitors must sign the waiver form before being allowed to compete.
10. Events will be held rain or shine. Dress for the weather.
11. Please make out a separate entry form for each dog, for each class.

DIRECTIONS

Basic directions are:

- **Take 103 South**
- **Take exit 11 for Lunenburg and turn left onto the 324 South**
- **Turn left onto 332 east (Signs for Blue Rocks and Fish processing plant)**
- **Turn left onto Blue Rocks Road**

Destination will be on the left - 619 Blue Rocks Road

Alternatively take Exit 10 and come through the town of Mahone Bay, then follow signs for Blue Rocks

Coming from other points, connect onto the 103 heading south and follow as above.

FLOWER'S FARM RULES

This is a working farm – please respect this by following some basic rules:

Parking for trial attendees and instinct test attendees is on the **lower driveway areas only**. No parking by the barn – reserved for farm owners, judges and coordinators. If your dog will not settle in the vicinity of the stock pen (barking, howling etc.) please move them to another location out of sight where they will settle. You are responsible for any significant damage/harm to livestock, other animals, etc. Signed waivers are required.

Ensure you CLOSE all gates behind you!

Pick up after your dog – yes there are other farm dogs living there – but we are guests of this property – stoop and scoop!

Do not enter any of the barns/outbuildings etc. without specific permission from the farm owner

There will be a porta potty on site

Please come prepared for the day

Bring plenty of water for you and for your dog

Bring a kennel/crate and/or be prepared to work out of your vehicle

Bring rain gear (including rubber boots – we run RAIN or SHINE)

If you wish to setup and use a tent or EZ up for shelter, you may do so. There is a pond on-site where dogs may swim to cool off.

AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that the Canadian Cardigan Corgi Club has the right to refuse this entry for cause, which the organizing committee shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this herding trial and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and win ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, officers, agents, superintendents, sponsors of the event and trial secretary and the owner or leasee of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the herding trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto. I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death, or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage, injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this herding trial, howsoever such injuries death or damage to property may be caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.
