I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in these shows and trials, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused and whether or not the same may have alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other person.

This ERN does not register a dog with the CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign born and foreign owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN number, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with a cheque or Visa/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature) in the amount of \$62.40 payable to the Canadian Kennel Club. Provide your complete address for return of the ERN. This Event Registration Number must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. 12-18 MONTHS – dogs between 12 months and under 18 months on day of show

**CANADIAN BRED** – dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country are excluded.

**BRED BY EXHIBITOR** – dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder for this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

OPEN CLASS - for all dogs

VETERAN CLASS – for all dogs over 7 years of age on day of show. These dogs will compete for regular placements and the winner of this class will go on to compete for

Best of Breed. Dogs competing in the Veteran Class may be spayed/neutered.

SPECIALS ONLY – dogs who are Canadian Champions. A CKC Registration

Number or ERN must be indicated on the entry form at time of closing.

#### SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES

Eligibility for the Altered Classes shall be limited to dogs over 6 months of age which have been spayed or neutered. Two classes will be offered: Altered Male and Altered Female:

Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winner from each class will be declared Winners and the second place winner will be declared Reserve Winners. The Altered Winners Male and the Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best of Breed Altered and Best of Opposite Sex Altered in breed.
