All dogs must be individually registered with the UKC, or possess a TL (Temporary Listing) number on the day of the show. TL's are available instantly online at https://www.ukcdogs.com/tl-numbers

PRE - ENTRY FEES

Additional dogs: \$20/ entry, same owner, same trial Day of Show entry: \$30 (if entry limit is not reached)

REFUND POLICY

Entries may be withdrawn before closing for full refund. Entries will be refunded for dogs which do not pass roll call, and lame and in season dogs. Substitutions will be allowed until the close of entries.

COLLARS. Catch collars, if used, must be flat buckle type collar, and not have any tags, ornaments, or anything hanging that might interfere with the dog. Any other type of collar is prohibited.

AWARDS

Flat Ribbons will be awarded for all qualifying runs.

PRACTICE

Practice may be offered when no entered dogs are waiting to run during the day, and following the completion of the afternoon trials on Saturday. The cost is \$10, and is payable as your dog is coming up to run. A sign-up sheet will be available.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- Entries without a fee will not be accepted.
- Lame dogs or bitches in season will be excused and their entry refunded, provided notice is given prior to or during roll call.
- Dogs not present at roll call shall be scratched.
- Muzzles and catch collars may be used at the handler's discretion.
- A \$10 fine will be assessed for loose dogs on the field after roll call and until after the last course.
- Bring your own water and shade.
- Please clean up after yourselves and your dogs. Do not stuff plastic bags down holes or in the port-apotty.
- We appreciate everyone's co-operation in keeping or site clean. There will be a \$10 fine for anyone caught not cleaning up after your hound.

- All entries must be submitted on the current "Official United Kennel Club Performance Entry Form". You may use one entry form to enter the same dog in more than one activity on the same weekend.
- 2. Use a separate entry form for each dog entered in a club's event.
- Mail all completed entry forms to the Event Secretary listed under the event, unless otherwise specified. Make checks payable to host club.
- All UKC Performance events are open to any UKC registered dogs and dogs with a valid Performance Listing/Limited Privilege number, with the exception of Lure Coursing and Drag Racing. Please see the rules for each event regarding eligibility.
- We want you to keep the points earned at UKC Licensed events. Important things to remember:
 - Dog not UKC registered? Apply for a Temporary Listing Number (TL) online at www.ukcdogs.com/tl-numbers. (TL fees are non-refundable, non-transferable and do not apply to the cost of permanent registration.)
 - All dogs entering UKC events must be permanently registered, have a valid Temporary Listing Number, or a Performance Listing/Limited Privilege number.
 - All entry forms must be completed and signed. Incorrect information submitted on the entry form may invalidate your wins.
- The United Kennel Club complies with the Americans with Disabilities Act. If you require an accommodation, please contact the Event Chair or Secretary for this club's event.
